

## Opening 12: Special Representative and Co-ordinator for Combating Trafficking in Human Beings - Simulation-based training (SR/CTHB/Simulation)

The Special Representative and Co-ordinator for Combating Trafficking in Human Beings (SR/CTHB) represents the OSCE at the political level on anti-trafficking issues. The Office of the SR/CTHB (OSR/CTHB) assists OSCE participating States in the implementation of commitments and full usage of recommendations set forth in the OSCE Action Plan to Combat Trafficking in Human Beings. The Office provides a co-ordinating function among OSCE structures and institutions involved in combating trafficking in human beings (CTHB) with a focus on the following activities: enhancing the awareness and understanding of THB across the OSCE region; policy planning and advocacy especially in the area of emerging trends of THB and effective approaches to combating THB; and direct assistance to participating States in practical and technical areas, at their request.

## Tasks and responsibilities:

- 1. Assists in preparation of the background files for the SR's country and technical assistance visits. Ensures the accurate gathering and structuring of information, particularly in the spotting of relevant trends and developments.
- 2. Contributes to the development of an Occasional Paper on reducing demand that fosters human trafficking for sexual exploitation.
- 3. Contributes to a survey to review the status of implementation of OSCE anti-trafficking commitments and recommended actions by the participating States building on the outcomes of the 2016 survey report as a baseline.
- 4. Supports the implementation of a second simulation-based training for a multi-disciplinary group of anti-trafficking practitioners from the Mediterranean region, such as law-enforcement, social and civil society organizations to be held in Vicenza, Italy in the framework of the project "Combating Human Trafficking along Mediterranean Migration Routes".
- 5. Supports the expansion of the simulation-based training exercises for national stakeholders in Albania, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan and other participating States as requested, in co-operation with national authorities and OSCE Field Operations as relevant.
- 6. Supports the reporting on Office's tasks/activities essential to de-brief or take stock of and follow-up on meetings, events, conferences, when necessary.
- 7. Participates/takes notes at internal meetings and follows up on associated tasks.
- 8. Assists the team in its daily activities and performs other duties as requested.
