The Crisis Management Centre (CMC Finland) and The Finnish Defence Forces International Centre (FINCENT) have established the Centre of Expertise in Comprehensive Crisis Management which will organise:

A Pilot Course on INTEGRATED CRISIS MANAGEMENT 24th to 28th November 2008

The course aims to familiarise participants with the integrated approach of crisis management with specific regards to the interaction of civilian and military actors. The course participants can either be civilian or military experts with experience from crisis management and peace building missions, those who are currently working in a crisis area or prospective participants to future missions.

APPLICATION OF THE CIVILIAN PARTICIPANTS

Civilian applicants interested in this course should send their CV and letter of motivation (max A4) to CMC Finland by email training@cmcf Finland.fi. The email header should read "ICM Application". Those applicants who have submitted their application and CV's earlier to CMC will also be taken into consideration in the selection process.

Applicants must have good English comprehension. Mission experience, earlier crisis management training or perspective on a forthcoming field mission is considered an asset. Only candidates who are taking part currently or willing to take part in civilian crisis management missions in the future will be considered. This course is aimed at middle and senior level experts such as Political Advisors, Development Advisors, Police Advisors, Heads and Deputy Heads of Offices, Executive Directors etc.

The application deadline is 12th September 2008, late applications will not be considered. Notice of acceptance will be sent by 30th September 2008.



Finnish applicants

The cost of the participation, including the travel arrangements within Finland, is free of cost for the Finnish nationals. No per diem is provided by CMC Finland. Participants are responsible for organising their own travel insurance.

Non-Finnish applicants

CMC Finland does not reimburse any travel expenses for non-Finnish participants. The participation (including program, meals, accommodation) is free of cost. Non-Finnish participants are required to make arrangements for their own travels. No per diem is provided by CMC Finland. APPLICATION OF THE MILITARY PARTICIPANTS

Military applicants interested in this course should send their CV and letter of motivation (max A4) to FINCENT by email to studentadmin@fincent.fi. The email header should read "ICM Application".

Applicants must have good English comprehension. Mission experience, earlier crisis management training or perspective on a forthcoming operation is considered an asset. Only candidates who are willing or who are planned to take part in military crisis management missions in the future will be considered. This course is aimed for Brigade and Battalion level experts such as contingent commanders, deputy commanders, J5/9 and G5/9 Head of Branches etc.

The application deadline is 12th September 2008, late applications will not be considered. Notice of acceptance will be sent by 30th September 2008.

Finnish applicants

The participation is free of cost. For the military participants, FINCENT provides per diem and travel costs according national regulations.

Non-Finnish applicants
